Ashland County Prosecuting Attorney Christopher R. Tunnell Announces November 2022 Felony Indictments

Today Ashland County Prosecuting Attorney Christopher R. Tunnell released fourteen (14) felony indictments issued by the Ashland County Grand Jury which met for a day and a half session in November. The Grand Jury issued a total of twenty-two (22) indictments, eight of which remain sealed because they have not been served as of today's date.
